

NEGRO FOUGHT FIREMEN

Accused by Woman of Attacking
Her on a Lot

The frantic cries of a woman for assistance late Saturday night aroused the members of the Kaighn avenue fire company in Camden. When Firemen Albert Hayden, Seth Monnell and William Rose ran across an adjoining lot they encountered a tall negro armed with a knife. A desperate but brief struggle ensued when the negro was captured. Subsequently Nettie Dickson, of 625 Sycamore street, walked into the fire house with her right thumb nearly severed. She said the man attacked her and during the struggle he cut her with the knife.

The negro was taken to the City Hall; where he gave the name of William Byers, who is also known to the police as "Sunlight."
