The gauze forms its own artificial blood clot with a gelatin-like film. The film develops minutes after the gauze comes in contact with the blood, the Foundation said.

5 Get Probation In Gaming Raid Case In Camden

CAMDEN — AP — Judge Thomas M. Madden of U. S. District Court has placed five men, one of them the brother of a city commissioner, on probation for failing to buy federal gambling stamps.

The judge also fined the defendants \$1,000 each Friday, but then suspended the fines. The probations ranged from three to five years.

State Police, led by Mayor Alfred R. Pierce, arrested the five in city-wide raids in November, 1959. As a result of the raids, Pierce later was ousted from

his job as head of the police department.

A Mount Pleasant justice of the peace sentenced Donald Martin Lanning, 22, of Mount Pleasant to 30 days in the Vallahalla penitentiary. The name of the friend was not disclosed.
