

Boat Threw Rowers Into River

Charles Solomon, aged 31 years, and Alexander Anderson, 40 years, of 1117 Knight street, Camden, had a thrilling experience through the capsizing of their row boat in the Delaware River yesterday afternoon. Both narrowly escaped drowning. The men started to row across the river to Camden from Washington

avenue wharf. Neither could swim. When they reached the middle of the river the boat turned over and both men were thrown out. They had enough presence of mind to grasp the boat. The accident was witnessed by the crew of the police boat Visitor, who came to the rescue. The two were sent to the Pennsylvania Hospital.
