

WIFE SUSPECTED BIGAMY

Had Husband Arrested and Lodged in Camden Jail

Successfully playing the role of an amateur sleuth, Mrs. Regina Rickart, of Sterner street, Philadelphia, broke down yesterday when her husband, Lewis Rickart, was arrested in Camden as a bigamist. She kissed him good-by and very apparently regretted her action in getting him behind the bars.

Rickart and his wife, who was Mrs. Regina Neef, were married in Camden, December 14, 1910, by Rev. Thilo Gorr, pastor of the German Lutheran Evangelical Church. They lived happily until a letter came from Germany, in which it was learned the man had another wife in the Fatherland. Mrs. Rickart visited Prosecutor Scovel and told her story, with the result that the wife agreed to get the man into the New Jersey jurisdiction. She inveigled him into visiting a vacant house with the idea of renting it, but when Rickart reached the Court House Detective Cherry was waiting and the man was placed under arrest.
