

SHOOTING VICTIM BETTER

Two Parties to Camden Tragedy Will Recover

Indications last night pointed to the recovery of Charles Ford, who tried suicide after murdering Mrs. May Effie Wagner and wounding Robert M. Wilson, at Laurel Springs, on Thursday. Doctors at Cooper Hospital, Camden, say that one of the two bullets he fired into his head is lodged at the base of the brain. The other made a scalp wound. He was resting easy yesterday, as was also Wilson, who is at the same institution. Wilson, too, has a good chance for recovery.

According to the county authorities, Wilson, after some differences at home, went to board with Mrs. Wagner. Ford, sullen because the woman had left him, learned of this condition, imbibed whisky freely, and while intoxicated tried double murder and suicide.
