

TROLLEY HIT PATROL WAGON

Policeman Tossed Twenty Feet and Severely Injured

Taking a common, ordinary "drunk" to the Camden City Hall last night a patrol wagon was struck in the rear by a trolley car at Broadway and Benson street. Policeman J. Casper Hart, one of the oldest men on the Camden force, was riding in the back of the patrol wagon. He was pitched about twenty feet and landed on his head.

In the excitement following the collision the prisoner quietly walked away. Policeman Hart, who lives on Mt. Vernon street above Second, was taken to the Cooper Hospital. He has two broken ribs and severe cuts, and bruises about the head.
